A MOTION approving the 1987-89 Biennial Developmental Disabilities Program Plan and authorizing the county executive to transmit the plan to the State of Washington, Department of Social and Health Services.

WHEREAS, state and federal funds are provided to King County to support a program of community-based services for those persons eligible for services from the State Division of Developmental Disabilities, and

WHEREAS, county receipt of state and federal funds is contingent upon review and approval by the Department of Social and Health Services of a biennial plan of services, and

WHEREAS, the Board for Developmental Disabilities has recommended to the King County council the 1987-89 Developmental Disabilities Program Plan which includes policies for the expenditure of both the state and federal funds;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The 1987-89 Biennium Developmental Disabilities Program Plan is hereby adopted by the King County council.

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to transmit the plan to the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) and enter into contracts with DSHS to provide developmental disabilities services consistent with the plan.
