2 A MOTION authorizing the Executive to enter into an interlocal  
3 agreement with the Northeast Sammamish Sewer and Water District  
4 to prepare a Ground Water Plan for the Redmond-Bear Creek Valley  
and accepting the Scope of Work for the Redmond-Bear Creek Valley  
Ground Water Management Plan.

5 WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology has instituted regulations under  
6 Chapter 173-100 WAC that provide for a process for long-term ground water supply  
7 protection, and

8 WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology has identified the Redmond-Bear Creek  
9 Valley as a Ground Water Management Area, and placed this area on the  
10 Department of Ecology's General Schedule, and

11 WHEREAS, the Ground Water Management Plan development may require the  
12 execution of interlocal agreements with participating agencies, and

13 WHEREAS, an interlocal agreement is required between King County and  
14 Northeast Sammamish Sewer and Water District to cover their financial participa-  
15 tion in the Ground Water Management process, and the interlocal states the pro-  
16 cedures for the transfer of funds from Northeast Sammamish Sewer and Water  
17 District in King County for their costs as identified in the attached Scope of  
18 Work, and

19 WHEREAS, planning and community development and health department staff have  
20 reviewed the Scope of Work and recommended approval;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22 A. The executive is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement  
23 (substantially in the form attached) with the Northeast Sammamish Sewer and  
24 Water District for the purpose of preparing a Ground Water Management Plan, and  
25 to cover the procedures by which the Northeast Sammamish Sewer and Water  
26 District transfers to King County the necessary funds to cover their costs as  
27 identified in the attached Scope of Work including the providing of the agreed  
28 in-kind work specified in the same Scope of Work.
