MOTION NO.

1 A MOTION authorizing the transfer of
2 jurisdiction of property from the department
3 of parks, planning and resources to the
4 department of public safety.

5 WHEREAS, the property totaling 23,400 square feet was acquired
6 for a potential gravel site by the department of public works in
7 January of 1930, and

8 WHEREAS, this property was transferred to the parks department
9 in March of 1947, and

10 WHEREAS, the department of parks, planning, and resources has
11 declared the property surplus to its needs, and

12 WHEREAS, the site is under the flight path of Seattle-Tacoma
13 International Airport which greatly limits its potential for other
14 uses, and

15 WHEREAS, the department of public safety wishes to construct a
16 Police Indoor Shooting Range for use by its officers and possibly
17 by the officers of the Port of Seattle, and

18 WHEREAS, the proposed range would be housed in a modest sized
19 building which would have little or no impact upon the park and
20 the routine activities performed by both the departments of parks,
21 planning and resource and public works in the abutting Sunset
22 Maintenance Shops;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

24 The King County executive is authorized to transfer the
25 jurisdiction of this land parcel from the department of parks,
26 planning and resources to the department of public safety which is
27 legally described as:

28 The South 180 feet of the North 425 feet of the East 160 feet
29 of the West 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of
30 Section 16, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M. King County,
31 Washington. Except the East 30 feet for road (18th Avenue
32 South).
