5 the temporary use of construction  
6 monies from CIP Project No. 002074  
7 Issaquah District Court to retain the  
8 County's option to purchase the pro-  
9 posed replacement site for the project.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

11 WHEREAS, the council by Motion No. 7040, previously  
12 authorized the expenditure of \$30,000 for the purpose of making  
13 option payments of \$10,000 per month for a maximum of three  
14 months on the proposed replacement property for the Issaquah  
15 District Court, and

16 WHEREAS, site development costs of the proposed replacement  
17 property, together with potential project overrun costs, render  
18 the proposed site unsuitable, and

19 WHEREAS, delays and cost overrun problems are also being  
20 experienced by other District Court Facilities CIP projects;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22 A. The authorization contained in paragraph A, Motion  
23 7040 to make the remaining \$10,000 payment for retaining the  
24 county's option to purchase the Issaquah District Court replacement  
25 site is hereby withdrawn.

26 B. The remaining \$10,000 will be restored to Task 003  
27 Construction of CIP No. 002074 Issaquah District Court and  
28 correspondingly deleted from Task 002 Acquisition.

29 PROVIDED THAT:

30 The \$10,000 can be paid and the provisions of Sections A  
31 and B shall be null and void if a 90 day extension of the option  
32 to purchase can be obtained from the owner of the property.




The Council hereby directs the executive to report on the needs of the Issaquah District Court within 90 days and how these needs will be met after January 1, 1989.
