2 A MOTION endorsing King County's increased  
3 financial support of the King County Economic  
4 Development Council and rescinding Motion 6053.

5 WHEREAS, Motion 6012 supported the creation of the Seattle/King  
6 County Economic Development Council to coordinate public and  
7 private economic development programs, encourage a diversified  
8 local economy, promote the retention and expansion of existing  
9 businesses, recruit new business, and further all economic  
10 development opportunities which are consistent with the land use  
11 policies and environmental standards of governments within King  
12 County, and

13 WHEREAS, a formula for funding the Seattle/King County  
14 Economic Development Council was adopted which would: 1) annually  
15 assess King County government, cities within King County,  
16 Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle (METRO) and the Port of  
17 Seattle ten cents for each person residing within their  
18 boundaries, up to a maximum of \$40,000; and 2) solicit private  
19 contributions equivalent to the public sector assessments, and

20 WHEREAS, the King County council and King County executive  
21 continue to support the public policy goal of promoting and  
22 enhancing economic development opportunities for the county's  
23 residents;

24 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:  
25 King County government, the cities within King County, the  
26 Port of Seattle, and the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle  
27 (METRO) further commit to an annual assessment of ten cents per  
28 person residing within their boundaries, up to a maximum of  
29 \$55,000 in 1988 and ensuing years.
