1 A MOTION concerning the need to establish a north-
2 south neighborhood collector street from SR 516
3 (S.E. 272nd Street) to SR 18, as called for by the
4 Tahoma/Raven Heights Communities Plan, in the
vicinity of 200th/204th Avenue S.E.

5 WHEREAS, the Tahoma/Raven Heights communities plan, enacted by
6 ordinance no. 6986, identifies the need for and proposes the
7 construction of a neighborhood collector street, to serve an area
8 designated for residential development between SR 516 (S.E. 272nd
9 Street, also known as the Kent-Kangley Road) on the south, and SR
10 18 on the north, between the existing residential developments
11 known as Timberline to the west and Cedar Downs to the east, and

12 WHEREAS, there have been submitted to King County proposed
13 subdivisions of portions of this area, for which construction of a
14 neighborhood collector street is required in order to lessen
15 congestion in the streets and highways and promote safe and
16 convenient travel by the public, as required by the state
17 subdivision act (RCW chapter 58.17);

18 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

19 The King County department of public works is requested to
20 propose an alignment or alignments for the neighborhood collector
21 street necessary to serve the area north of SR 518, south of SR
22 18, east of the development of Timberline and west of the
23 development of Cedar Downs, and to process a request or requests
24 for the establishment of a street along such alignment(s), based
25 upon surveying and mapping to be provided, according to standards
26 of the department of public works, by persons interested in
27 developing the properties which would be served by such street.
