WHEREAS, the county council has, through Ordinance 8331  
authorized the expenditure of 1988 Community Development Block  
Grant funds for historic preservation projects, and

WHEREAS, the landmarks commission has reviewed project  
proposals based on published criteria and has named three  
restoration projects as the highest priority for 1988 CDBG  
assistance, and

WHEREAS, the county executive has reviewed and concurred with  
these recommendations;

The King County council endorses the county executive's  
allocation of historic preservation CDBG funds for the following  
restoration projects as recommended by the landmarks commission;
