A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$24,560 to support a Litter Control and Recycling Program, grant File No. 808.

WHEREAS, the Model Litter and Recycling Act of 1979, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Department of Ecology for programs to control litter, and

WHEREAS, the Litter Control and Recycling Program will address the litter problems caused by the improper disposal of household goods, particularly at charitable agency drop sites, and will develop plans to control disposal of household goods, and

WHEREAS, the council of King County recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$6,140 as a cash match in support of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$24,560 to the department of ecology for a litter control and recycling program on behalf of King County;

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

The department of ecology is hereby assured of full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
