A MOTION authorizing King County to enter into an agreement with the City of Seattle for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a sewer transmission line in Council District No. 5.

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle has filed an application for a franchise to construct, operate, and maintain a sewer transmission line in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010, and

WHEREAS, the City's comprehensive plan was approved on July 30, 1984 by King County Council Ordinance No. 6866, and

WHEREAS, the application has been referred to the relevant county executive departments for review, and

WHEREAS, the county executive and the Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC) have recommended approval of the franchise;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The granting of a franchise to the City of Seattle to construct, operate and maintain a sewer transmission line within King County is hereby approved. The county executive is hereby authorized to enter into and execute the sewer franchise, which by this reference is fully incorporated as part of the motion. Said franchise is granted to the City of Seattle and shall expire on April 21, 2000, concurrent with its Franchise No. 1941. Said franchise shall include all of the general and special conditions required by the county.


B. If within 30 days after the granting of this franchise, the applicant shall have failed to sign the written acceptance incorporated herein, then the herein rights and privileges granted shall be forfeited and said franchise shall be null and void.
