A MOTION authorizing the county executive to execute contracts under the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Revised Code of Washington Chapter 39.34

WHEREAS, King County, State of Washington, discharges its responsibility to furnish police service to its citizens by its department of public safety ("the department") under the authority of the county executive, and

WHEREAS, the cities of Bellevue, Hunts Point, Kirkland, Redmond and Yarrow Point ("the cities") desire to avail themselves of the marine law enforcement service of the department during certain months and hours of operation, and

WHEREAS, the cities are not readily able to furnish such service without incurring costs in excess of those necessary to reimburse the department for providing that service, and

WHEREAS, the cities are willing to reimburse the department for such service and the department is willing to provide that service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is hereby authorized to contract with the cities of Bellevue, Hunts Point, Kirkland, Redmond and Yarrow Point for the furnishing of marine law enforcement service by the department of public safety.
