MOTION NO. 7192

A MOTION authorizing the 1988 Board of Equalization to convene early to begin hearings on the 1988 assessments appeals

WHEREAS, the Board of Equalization has nearly completed the prior year's petitions, and

WHEREAS, State law sets the first Monday in July for convening the Board to begin to act on 1988 assessment appeals, and

WHEREAS, State law and the King County Code provide for the convening of the Board at any time when petitions filed exceed ten percent of the number of appeals filed in the preceding year, and

WHEREAS, the 1988 appeals filed now exceeds ten percent of the number of appeals filed in 1987, and

WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to all concerned for the Board to proceed to work on these appeals; and

WHEREAS, no undesirable consequence is anticipated from convening earlier than required by law,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Pursuant to RCW 84.48.010 and KCC 2.34, the 1988 Board of Equalization is authorized to convene as of June 1, 1988 for the purpose of holding hearings on the 1988 property assessment appeals, provided that decisions on these appeals will be issued on or after July 5, 1988, the date of the formal certification of the assessment roll.
