A MOTION related to the King County Park System: waiving competitive bidding and M/WBE requirements for asbestos removal at Evergreen and Shoreline Pools.

WHEREAS, the King County safety office conducted an asbestos survey that resulted in an appropriation of funds for asbestos removal in 1988, and

WHEREAS, subsequent detailed design by the natural resources and parks division uncovered the existence of previously unreported asbestos at Evergreen Pool and more extensive asbestos at Shoreline Pool than previously reported, and

WHEREAS, the natural resources and parks division also received funding for other work at these sites including roof repairs, ceiling repairs and replacement of pool liners which would require future pool closures to accomplish, and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to accomplish all of this work at one time thereby minimizing the number and length of pool closures, and

WHEREAS, the ordinary requirements for competitive bidding and M/WBE participation in construction contracts per K.C.C. 4.18 must be waived for the highly specialized asbestos removal portion of this project in order to prevent delays in beginning such work:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The county council declares that an emergency exists in King County whereby the public interest would suffer material injury if necessary rehabilitation work at the Evergreen and Shoreline Pools is delayed.

The ordinary requirements for competitive bidding and M/WBE participation per K.C.C. 4.18 are hereby waived for that portion of construction activity at the Evergreen and Shoreline Pools related exclusively to asbestos removal. All competitive bidding and M/WBE requirements for all other elements of construction activity at the Evergreen and Shoreline Pools shall remain in full force and effect.
