MOTION NO. 7198

A MOTION authorizing the retention of bond counsel in connection with a proposed ballot issue seeking approval of the sale of bonds to finance capital projects for parks and open space, youth facilities and the aquarium.

WHEREAS, King County is proposing capital projects for parks and open space, youth facilities and the aquarium, and

WHEREAS, funding for such capital improvements will be placed on the September ballot for voter approval, and

WHEREAS, the County requires bond counsel services for preparation of the documents related to the ballot issue and in connection with the issuance of bonds to fund such projects should they be approved;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Foster, Pepper and Shefelman, attorneys at law in the state of Washington, are hereby selected as bond counsel to perform services in connection with placing a ballot issue before the electorate seeking approval of financing for the proposed capital projects for parks and open space, youth facilities and the aquarium, and subsequent issuance of unlimited tax general obligation bonds to fund such projects should they be approved.
