A MOTION establishing a committee to advise the council and the executive concerning the design and future operations of the competitive swimming facility to be constructed in Federal Way.

WHEREAS, a world class fifty meter competitive swimming facility is to be constructed on land donated by the Weyerhaeuser Company in Federal Way, and

WHEREAS, this facility will be the site of the swimming and diving events for the 1990 Goodwill Games and is intended to be the site of future regional, national and international competition, and

WHEREAS, organized competitive swimming has long been established in both Pierce and King Counties, and

WHEREAS, this facility will be only one of four internationally certified fifty meter pools in the United States, and

WHEREAS, King County is contracting with Berkley Engineering and Construction Company to design and construct the facility, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to insure that the design and future operations of the facility meet the needs of competitive swimming organizations and the public at large, and

WHEREAS, the Council seeks to cooperate with the City of Tacoma, the Metropolitan Park District and Pierce County to facilitate regional access to this unique facility;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. There is hereby established an advisory committee to the council for the purposes of reviewing the development of the design for the competitive swimming and diving facility and for recommending plans and programs for assuring regional access to the facility following construction.

1 B. The committee shall be comprised of the following members:

2 1. Two members of the King County council appointed by the
3 council chairman;

4 2. The mayor of Tacoma;

5 3. The chair of the Pierce County Council;

6 4. The chair of the Tacoma Metropolitan Park District;

7 5. Three representatives of competitive swimming
8 organizations, one from Pierce County and one from King County,
9 including one representing competitive diving;

10 6. The King County executive;

11 7. Two representatives from the Pacific Northwest Aquatics
12 Foundation;

13 8. One representative of the Goodwill Games Seattle
14 Organizing Committee.

15 C. Staff support to the committee shall be contributed by
16 the participating governmental jurisdictions and shall be
17 coordinated by King County's pool contract coordinator, who shall
18 give periodic reports to the committee.

19 D. The committee shall select a chair from its members.

20 E. The committee shall:

21 1. Review the design of the facility and make
22 recommendations to the pool contract coordinator;

23 2. Submit a report to the council recommending plans and
24 programs for the future operation of the facility by June 1, 1990.

25 F. The committee shall disband upon completion of these
26 tasks.
