MOTION NO. 7237

A MOTION authorizing an interlocal agreement between King County and the Port of Seattle to cooperate in the construction and maintenance of the Tye Regional Detention Pond.

WHEREAS, King County and the Port of Seattle have a mutual interest in restoring Des Moines Creek and preventing future damage to the water quality and salmonid habitat of Des Moines Creek, and

WHEREAS, the Des Moines Creek Watershed Management Plan project, in which both King County and the Port participated along with others, identified the Tye Regional Detention Pond as the highest priority project to restore Des Moines Creek and prevent damage due to storm and surface water runoff, and

WHEREAS, the preferred location for this project is on property owned by the Port of Seattle;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement with the Port of Seattle for the construction and maintenance of the Tye Regional Detention Pond on property owned by the Port within the Tye Valley Golf Course.
