MOTION NO. 7253

A MOTION authorizing King County to enter into an agreement with the City of Kirkland for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a sewer system in Council District No. 3.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has filed an application for a franchise to construct, operate, and maintain a sewer main in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010, and

WHEREAS, the City's comprehensive plan was approved on May 29, 1984 by King County Council Ordinance No. 6799, and

WHEREAS, the application has been referred to the county executive for review, and

WHEREAS, the county executive has recommended approval of the franchise;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The granting of a franchise to the City of Kirkland to construct, operate and maintain a sewer system within King County is hereby approved. The county executive is authorized to enter into and execute the sewer system franchise which by this reference is fully incorporated herein as part of the motion. Said franchise is granted to the City of Kirkland and shall expire on December 9, 1999, concurrent with its Franchise No. 1832. Said franchise shall include all of the general and special conditions required by the county.

B. If within 30 days after the granting of this franchise, the applicant shall have failed to sign the written acceptance incorporated herein, then the herein rights and privileges granted shall be forfeited and said franchise shall be null and void.
