PROPOSED NO. 88 - 489

MOTION NO. 7261

A MOTION requesting that the executive create a Trust and Contributions Fund for the Summer Day Camp Program Scholarship Fund, and providing instruction and guidance on its administration and maintenance.

WHEREAS, the King County council strongly supports programs that encourage higher education, and

WHEREAS, the county council recognizes the strong interest of the private sector in encouraging the higher education of our youth, and

WHEREAS, low and moderate income youth employed by the County Summer Youth Employment Training Program are in need of encouragement and assistance in continuing their post-secondary educations, and

WHEREAS, the county has a compelling interest in the ability of youth to contribute to their community and to pursue a higher education, and

WHEREAS, the county council will lead an effort to raise scholarship funds in the amount of \$1,000 for each youth successfully participating as a summer day camp counselor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

A. The county executive is requested to create a Trust and Contribution Fund, consistent with the provisions of King County Code 2.80. All gifts, bequests and donations received as a result of the council's efforts to raise scholarship monies to help fund higher education at accredited institutions of each youth employed through the County Summer Youth Employment Training Program who successfully completes the Summer Day Camp Program as a counselor, shall be deposited in the fund and held in trust until such time as the youths are enrolled in an accredited program of higher education.

B. The county executive is requested to formulate and devise such procedures consistent with the provisions of the Internal Revenue Code, including Section 117, which will ensure the appropriate receipt, deposit, accounting for, and disbursement of all funds received subsequent to the council's efforts to raise funds specific to this stated purpose.

C. The county executive is requested to assign to the department of human resources, work training program, the overall responsibility for the administration, maintenance, deposit and disbursement of the scholarship funds.

D. This motion authorizes the receipt of any, and all, gifts, bequests and donations which may be made to the Summer Day Camp Program Scholarship Fund by any individual, corporation, foundation, or other entity, during the time that the Summer Day Camp Program and the Scholarship Fund may exist.
