A MOTION approving the King County Executive's expenditure proposals for 1988 centennial grants, and authorizing the release of funds for the King County Centennial Program.

WHEREAS, the county council by Ordinance 8331 has appropriated \$250,000 in current expense funding for 1988 centennial projects, with up to \$50,000 of that amount allocated to heritage grants, and \$25,000 for centennial commission sponsored programs, and WHEREAS, the county council by a proviso to Ordinance 8331, Section 80, has required the centennial commission to submit its expenditure proposals for council approval, and

WHEREAS, the centennial commission has reviewed project proposals based on published criteria and has recommended eighteen projects as the highest priority for 1988 centennial grant assistance, and

WHEREAS, the county executive has reviewed and concurred with these recommendations;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County council authorizes the release of \$175,000 for the centennial grants program and approves the county executive's expenditure proposals for the following 1988 grant projects as recommended by the centennial commission:
