A MOTION naming the land donated to the citizens of King County by Thomas Burr Wooton and Frederica Mary Wooton and authorizing Gerald R. Kingen to develop this land as a public park.

WHEREAS, the Wooton family donated approximately two acres overlooking Puget Sound to King County for park purposes, and

WHEREAS, this land is suitable for a park, as proposed by King County, and

WHEREAS, King County will manage the design and development of the proposed park, and

WHEREAS, development of this valuable property will bring enjoyment to all residents of the state of Washington for generations to come, and

WHEREAS, Gerald R. Kingen, a resident of King County, has proposed to pay for the park design and development, and

WHEREAS, the King County council appreciates the generosity shown by Gerald R. Kingen;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. Land donated to the citizens of King County by Thomas Burr Wooton and Frederica Mary Wooton shall become a King County park named Thomas B. and Frederica M. Wooton Park.

B. The county executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Gerald R. Kingen to design and develop the park at his own expense.
