A MOTION expressing support of the King County council for the proposed Northshore Park and Recreation Service Area Proposition No. 1, titled "Senior Citizen Activity Center Bonds - \$3.6 million: Shall the Northshore Park and Recreation Service Area issue \$3.6 million of general obligation bonds to acquire property, construct a senior activities center thereon, and pay related costs, such bonds to be payable from property tax levies in excess of regular property tax levies, and maturing within a maximum term of twenty years from the date of issue?"

WHEREAS, the Board of the Northshore Park and Recreation Service Area has placed a \$3.6 million bond issue on the November 8, 1988 general election ballot for the purpose of acquiring property and constructing a senior activities center, and

WHEREAS, senior services in the Northshore Park and Recreation Service Area have been provided in multiple locations because the senior center has been outgrown and is too small, and a new facility would allow services to be consolidated and provided in a convenient location, and

10 Shall the Northshore Park and Recreation Service Area issue
11 \$3.6 million of general obligation bonds to acquire property,
12 construct a senior activities center thereon, and pay related
13 costs, such bonds to be payable from property tax levies in
14 excess of regular property tax levies, and maturing within a
15 maximum term of twenty years from the date of issue?"
