A MOTION authorizing a local service area (LSA) boundary adjustment to include an area known as Mary, Queen of Peace Parish.

WHEREAS, section 6.5 of the sewerage general plan, adopted by Ordinance 4035, authorizes minor local service area (LSA) boundary adjustments to be approved by motion, and

WHEREAS, comprehensive plan policy F-316 establishes the criteria for LSA boundary adjustment approval, and

WHEREAS, the proposed Mary, Queen of Peace Parish LSA boundary adjustment, described in attachments A and B of this motion, is a minor adjustment necessitated by a building permit application, and

WHEREAS, the proposed Mary, Queen of Peace Parish LSA boundary adjustment is consistent with comprehensive plan policy F-316;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County Council adopts the revised examiner's report and recommendation to the county council regarding the Mary, Queen of Peace Parish LSA boundary adjustment, dated October 28, 1988.

B. The King County Council approves the requested extension of the LSA boundary to include the Mary, Queen of Peace Parish property described in attachments A and B of this motion.
