WHEREAS, the King County council has through Motion Nos.
4151, 5070 and 5226 authorized King County to participate
financially in the construction of the City of Seattle's West
Seattle Bridge Project, and

WHEREAS, an interlocal agreement was executed pursuant to those Motions on the 22nd day of June, 1981, and

WHEREAS, the King County council wishes to affirm its commitment to proceed with construction of Phase II of the Project, and

WHEREAS, the construction of Phase II has been changed to provide for greater flexibility by incorporating a two-lane moveable structure bridge, and

WHEREAS, the County's Phase I commitment to the Project has been completed, and

WHEREAS, King County council wishes to continue its cooperative and mutually beneficial support of the construction of this Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. King County council authorizes the county executive to enter into the attached amendment to the West Seattle Freeway Bridge Interlocal Agreement with the City of Seattle to accomplish King County's contribution to Phase II of the West Seattle Bridge Project.

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FIRST AMENDMENT TO WEST SEATTLE FREEWAY BRIDGE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO	the West Seattle Bridg	ge Interlocal Agreement is
entered into as of	, 1988 t	between KING COUNTY, a
municipal corporation (the	County) and THE CITY OF	F SEATTLE, a municipal
corporation, (the City).		

RECITALS:

- A. The parties hereto entered into the West Seattle Freeway Interlocal Agreement dated June 22, 1981, (the Agreement), which provided certain terms and conditions for accomplishment of the West Seattle Freeway Bridge Project (the Project).
- B. The County having completed its required Phase I commitment, the parties wish to reaffirm their Phase II commitments as established in the Agreement as amended herein to proceed with construction of Phase II of the Project.
- C. In order to provide for efficient completion of Phase II of the Project, the City and the County desire to make certain changes to the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefits and promises contained in the Agreement and in this Amendment thereto, the County and the City agree as follows:

- 1. Section I of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:
- I. DEFINITIONS

The term, "Project," as applied hereinafter to the West Seattle Freeway Bridge, refers to the proposed construction of a six-lane, high-level bridge and the removal of Spokane Street Bascule Bridge No. 1, hereinafter referred to as Phase I and to the construction of a two-lane moveable structure bridge with a minimum horizontal clearance of 250 feet and a minimum clearance bridge height of 55 feet (measured from center span to center channel at medium high water) across the West Waterway to provide local access to Harbor Island and the removal of Spokane Street Bascule Bridge No. 2, hereinafter referred to as Phase II.

- 2. Section IIIA.1 of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:
- 1. The design, construction, operation and maintenance of the two-lane moveable structure bridge with a minimum horizontal clearance of 250 feet and a minimum bridge height of 55 feet (measured from center span to center channel at medium high water) and removal of the Spokane Street Bascule Bridge No. 2.
 - 3. Section IV.A of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:
- A. The County having fulfilled its financial obligation for Phase I, shall pay the City, for use in connection with the construction only of Phase II of the Project, a sum not to exceed Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000).
 - 4. Section V.F of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:
- F. The timing of progress billings by the City for Phase II shall be proportionate to the timing of the expenditure of city funds for the project. King County shall make payment within 120 days of the first billing and within thirty (30) days after receipt of subsequent billings. No County contribution will be made to Phase II if the City fails to commence construction of the Phase II project within eight years of the completion of Phase I.
- 5. There is added to the Agreement a new Section V.J to read as follows:
- J. The City may withdraw from the West Seattle Freeway Fund or successor fund, immediately after the opening of bids for Phase II of the Project, funds in excess of funds reasonably expected to be needed for Project completion. Upon any withdrawal of funds, the City will immediately reimburse the County 10/197 of the withdrawn amount.
- 6. There is added to the Agreement a new Section V.K to read as follows:
- K. If, upon opening of bids for the principal construction contract for Phase II of the Project, total Project costs exceed the current estimated cost to complete Phase II of the Project (see Attachment A, hereto) of Forty-six Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$46,300,000), the City

may, after adoption of a resolution for such purpose, void and cancel this agreement as amended upon delivery of written notice of such resolution to the County before expiration of bids. Upon delivery of such notice, all terms and provisions of this agreement as amended shall be void and of no further effect.

- 7. Except as expressly amended herein, all provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
- 8. This First Amendment to the West Seattle Freeway Bridge Interlocal Agreement shall become effective and binding when executed by both parties.
