5 A MOTION authorizing the County
6 Executive to make a grant application
7 for funds in the approximate amount of
8 \$110,000 to support in part the
9 preparation of an update of the King
10 County Comprehensive Solid Waste
11 Management Plan, Grant File No. 833.

12 WHEREAS, King County is required by R.C.W. 70.95 to prepare a
13 coordinated comprehensive solid waste management plan which will
14 guide development of solid waste management plans and programs in
15 King County and will include the estimated long-range needs for
16 solid waste facilities projected twenty years into the future, and

17 WHEREAS, The Hazardous Waste Cleanup Act provides for the
18 award of grants by the Department of Ecology for solid waste
19 planning, and \$110,000 of the available grant funds have been set
20 aside for use by class AA counties, and

21 WHEREAS, the City of Seattle has committed to preparing a
22 solid waste management plan for the City of Seattle to be
23 integrated with the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste
24 Management Plan (KCSWMP) in accordance with R.C.W. 70.95.080(1),
25 and

26 WHEREAS, King County shall allocate \$38,500 of this grant to
27 the City of Seattle for the city to prepare a solid waste plan,
28 and

29 WHEREAS, the council of King County recognizes an obligation
30 to provide the amount of \$71,500 in cash and/or direct services
31 as a match in support of the project, and

32 WHEREAS, the \$71,500 match for the grant shall be met through
33 1988 appropriated expenditure authority, and

1 WHEREAS, the City of Seattle has an obligation to provide the
2 amount of \$38,500 in cash and/or direct services as a match
3 support of the project;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


5 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make
6 application for funds in the approximate amount of \$110,000 to
7 the Department of Ecology for the King County Comprehensive Solid
8 Waste Management Plan on behalf of King County,

9 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file
10 and execute such application, and to allocate such funds to the
11 City of Seattle,


12 C. The Department of Ecology is hereby assured of full
13 compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
