MOTION NO. 7390

A MOTION authorizing King County to enter into an agreement with the City of Kent for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a water system in Council District 9.

WHEREAS, the City of Kent has filed an application for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a water system to serve primarily a residential area with some commercial and agricultural areas in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010, and

WHEREAS, the City of Kent's comprehensive plan was approved on July 1, 1985 by King County Council Ordinance No. 7249, and

WHEREAS, the application has been referred to the relevant county executive departments for review, and

WHEREAS, the county executive and Utilities Technical Review Committee have recommended approval of the franchise;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The granting of a franchise to the City of Kent to construct, operate and maintain a water system within King County is hereby approved. The county executive is authorized to enter into and execute the water system franchise, which by this referenced is fully incorporated herein as part of the motion. Said franchise is granted to the City of Kent and to expire on October 23, 1998, concurrent with their Franchise No. 1315. Said franchise shall include all of the general and special conditions required by the county.


B. If within 30 days after the granting of this franchise, the applicant shall have failed to sign the written acceptance incorporated herein, then the herein rights and privileges granted shall be forfeited and said franchise shall be null and void.
