4 A MOTION expressing the appreciation of
5 the King County Council to GARY GRANT
6 for his strong effective leadership as
7 King County Council Chair during the
8 years 1987 - 1988.

9 WHEREAS, GARY GRANT was elected to serve as a King County
10 Councilman from from District 9 in 1987 and is the only member
11 chosen by his peers to serve as Chair for four years, during
12 1984-1985, and 1987-1988, and

13 WHEREAS, under his leadership, during 1987 and 1988, the
14 Council has adopted significant legislation, which includes, in
15 part:

16 establishing four citizens ad hoc advisory committees that
17 developed recommendations which reestablished recycling as
18 the County's priority in reducing solid waste;
19 initiating the development of a juvenile arson prevention
20 program;
21 developing the Health and Human Services Policy for
22 allocation of the 1988 unincorporated sales tax dedicated by
23 the Council for health and human services for the citizens of
24 King County;
25 initiating the DNA genetic print evidence gathering and
26 storage program for successful prosecution of sexual assault
27 cases;
28 creating the Summer Day Camp Reading/Scholarship Program;
29 establishing a Family and Children's Commission;
30 initiating an emergency response system pilot project for the
31 elderly and handicapped;
32 authorizing a successful bond election to rehabilitate the
33 juvenile detention facility;
authorizing a home detention program to reduce the
non-violent jail population;

1 extending the voter information pamphlet program, first
2 initiated for the 1987 general election;
3 initiating the Automated Fingerprint Identification System;
4 requiring sprinkler systems in some new construction, and
5 passing additional fire control measures, and

6 WHEREAS, though charting an ambitious and sometimes
7 controversial course for the Council, GARY GRANT maintained his
8 sense of humor and characteristic wit;

9 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County;

10 The King County Council wishes to show appreciation to GARY
11 GRANT for his hard work and leadership during his 1987-1988 terms
12 as Chair of the King County Council.
