A MOTION authorizing the King County executive

to submit the Comprehensive Homeless Assistance
Plan and an application for funding to the U. S.
Department of Housing and Urban Development for
the Emergency Shelter Grant Program.

WHEREAS, the federal government through the adoption and administration

of Subtitle B of the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Act of 1987 will make \$46,500,000 of 1989 Emergency Shelter Grant Program funds available nationwide, and

WHEREAS, King County as an urban county is entitled to \$70,000, and WHEREAS, the federal government through the regulations for the Emergency Shelter Grant Program requires King County to submit an application for the funds and a Comprehensive Homeless Assistance Plan to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, and

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Homeless Assistance Plan will contain a strategy to match the needs of the homeless in King County with the resources available, and

WHEREAS, the current supply of emergency shelter will be maintained through lease payments, and

WHEREAS, emergency shelter service and facilities will be improved through operating and rehabilitation and renovation funds, and

WHEREAS, homeless prevention assistance will be provided; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The King County executive is hereby authorized to submit a 1989 program application and Comprehensive Homeless Assistance Plan to the U.
