7 A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make an  
8 application for funds in the amount of \$131,800, to fund one  
9 project to improve the quality of life for developmentally  
10 disabled persons.

11 WHEREAS, the Right to Education for All Act, Public Law 94-142, authorizes  
12 services to students with deafness and blindness, and

13 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Education has announced services to  
14 students with deafness and blindness to be a funding priority for fiscal year  
15 1989-90, and

16 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Education is accepting applications  
17 for projects that will improve the quality of life for students with deafness  
18 and blindness, and

19 WHEREAS, there currently are no adult services readily available that  
20 assists students transition into society nor with permanent housing, and

21 WHEREAS, the project will be a collaborative effort between King County  
22 human services division, Educational Services District 121, and the State of  
23 Washington Division of Developmental Disabilities, and

24 WHEREAS, the project will be designed to provide knowledge to school  
25 districts, social service agencies, state and local government, family members,  
26 housing development organizations, and community groups on techniques related to  
27 transitional planning and creative housing strategies, and

28 WHEREAS, the project will include at least fourteen students with deafness  
29 and blindness, and

30 WHEREAS, the council of King County recognizes an obligation to provide an  
31 in-kind contribution of staff time;

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

33 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for  
funds in the approximate amount of \$131,800 to the U.S. Department of Education



2 for a project relating to the improvement of the quality of life for the  
3 developmentally disabled on behalf of King County for the estimated time period  
4 of August 1, 1989 through July 31, 1990;

5 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such  
6 application and to enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the  
7 grantor;


8 C. The King County executive is also authorized to employ project staff to  
9 enter into or execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation  
10 of the project.
