A MOTION adopting the 1990 King County Community Development Block Grant Consortium Policy Plan, including the administrative setaside, and the 1990 Local Program Policies for the Pass-through Cities funds and for the County and Small Cities funds, including the King County regional earmarks for 1990.

WHEREAS, King County is a member of the King County Community Development Block Grant Consortium, and

WHEREAS, King County as the official applicant is responsible to the federal government for all activities undertaken in the King County Consortium with Community Development Block Grant funds, and

WHEREAS, the 1988-1990 Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between the governing body of King County and participating incorporated jurisdictions within King County sets forth an arrangement for planning the distribution of Community Development Block Grant funds, including the administrative setaside, and

WHEREAS, federal Community Development Block Grant legislation requires King County to adopt an annual community development plan to guide the use of Community Development Block Grant funds and identify community development and housing needs, and

WHEREAS, the 1990 King County Community Development Block Grant Consortium Policy Plan (hereinafter referred to as the 1990 CDBG Consortium Policy Plan) meets the federal Community Development Block Grant requirements for an annual plan for the year January 1, 1990 to December 31, 1990, and

WHEREAS, King County citizens and Consortium members have participated in the development of the 1990 CDBG Consortium Policy Plan through review and comment, and

WHEREAS, the Consortium's Joint Policy Committee endorsed the 1990 CDBG Consortium Policy Plan, including the administrative setaside, and

1 WHEREAS, the formula for the distribution of county CDBG funds
 2 among three designated regions of unincorporated King County
 3 (northeast, southeast, and southwest) adopted in Motion 5746 has
 4 now been updated to include the small incorporated cities which
 5 now participate in the County and Small Cities fund, and is now
 6 incorporated in the 1990 CDBG Local Program Policies for the
 7 County and Small Cities funds;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


9 A. The attached 1990 King County Community Development Block
 10 Grant Consortium Policy Plan including the administrative
 11 setaside, and the 1990 Local Program Policies for the Pass-through
 12 Cities and for the County and Small Cities fund, including the
 13 regional earmarks, are hereby adopted to guide the planning and
 14 development of the 1990 Community Development Block Grant Program.

15 B. All eligible applications shall be given consideration.

16 C. The county council requests the executive to instruct the
 17 planning and community development division and the office of
 18 civil rights to explore alternatives to WMBE implementation with
 19 regard to the Community Development Interim Loan Program. The
 20 results would be considered as a part of the 1990 King County
 21 budget process. A report on the result of this exploration will
 22 be presented to the King County council by February 1, 1990.
