MOTION NO. 7543

A MOTION authorizing King County to enter into an agreement with the City of Auburn for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a water and sewer system in Council District 9.

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn has filed an application for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a water and sewer system to serve a residential area in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010, and

WHEREAS, the City's comprehensive plans were approved on October 17, 1983, by King County Ordinance 6563 for the water and on February 8, 1982, by King County Ordinance 5876 for the sewer, and

WHEREAS, the application has been referred to the relevant county executive departments for review, and

WHEREAS, the county executive and the Utilities Technical Review Committee have recommended approval for the franchise;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The granting of a franchise to the City of Auburn to construct, operate and maintain a water and sewer system within King County is hereby approved. The county executive is authorized to enter into and execute the water and sewer system franchise, which by this reference is fully incorporated herein as part of the motion. Said franchise is granted to the City of Auburn to expire on November 30, 1994, concurrent with its Franchise 250. Said franchise shall include all of the general and special conditions required by the county.


B. If within 30 days after the granting of this franchise, the applicant shall have failed to sign the written acceptance incorporated herein, then the herein rights and privileges granted shall be forfeited and said franchise shall be null and void.
