MOTION NO. 7552

A MOTION to establish a 17-member School Mitigation Task Force.

WHEREAS, the King County council appropriated \$50,000 to building and land development to implement an interlocal agreement between King County and Educational Service District 121 to develop proposed regulations and procedures regarding the impact of new development on schools, and

WHEREAS, a school mitigation study consultant will be retained by Educational Service District 121 to assist in implementing the interlocal agreement and to identify alternative solutions in dealing with new development on schools, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 8874 provided for a 17-member School Mitigation Task Force to develop regulations and procedures to deal with the impact of new development on schools;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. A school mitigation task force shall be established comprising the following five representatives from school districts, five representatives from the development community, five representatives from the general public, one representative from the King County council and one representative from the King County building and land development division:




