5 A MOTION, committing Community Development Block Grant  
6 (CDBG) funds for the Housing Authority of the County  
7 of King (HACK) to accomplish the minimum security  
8 requirements for rental residential units as set forth  
9 in King County Ordinances 8958 and 8959.

10 WHEREAS, the King County council recognizes the importance of minimum  
11 security standards in multi-family buildings, and

12 WHEREAS, the King County council passed Ordinances <sup>8958</sup> 8959 which sets  
13 forth requirements for minimum security standards, and

14 WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the County of King has 1,000 rental  
15 residential units in unincorporated King County which may not be equipped  
16 with the minimum security hardware described in Ordinances <sup>8958</sup> 8959, and

17 WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the County of King is concerned  
18 about the availability of funding to accomplish a minimum security retrofit  
19 project, and

20 WHEREAS, community development block grant funds can be used for this  
21 project;


22 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

23 The King County Council agrees to commit community development block  
24 grant funds up to a total of \$60,000 to be funded in the program years of  
25 1990 and 1991 to be used for installation of minimum security hardware as  
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1 specified in Ordinances <sup>8958</sup> 8959 in rental units operated by the Housing  
2 Authority of the County of King, provided the Housing Authority of the  
3 County of King submits the proper application forms to the Department of  
4 Planning and Community Development within the required deadlines.


