WHEREAS, Bea's unflagging sense of humor and compassion and her generous spirit have guided the Northwest AIDS Foundation's growth from a one-person organization to an expert, professional staff of 35, and

WHEREAS, The network of AIDS care and education in King County is recognized across the country as a flagship for the nation, for which Bea should take much of the credit, and

WHEREAS, Bea has announced her intention to leave the Foundation to pursue her educational and personal goals;




BE IT FURTHER MOVED,
