

MOTION NO. 7603

A MOTION authorizing King County to enter into an agreement with the City of Kent for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a transmission line system in Council District 9.

WHEREAS, the City of Kent has filed an application for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a water transmission line system in order to reconstruct and repair the Kent Springs Transmission Main Pipeline in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010, and

WHEREAS, the City's comprehensive plan was approved on July 1, 1985, by King County Ordinance 7249, and

WHEREAS, the application has been referred to the relevant county executive departments for review, and

WHEREAS, the county executive and the Utilities Technical Review Committee have recommended approval of the franchise;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The granting of a franchise to the City of Kent to construct, operate and maintain a water transmission line system within King County is hereby approved. The county executive is authorized to enter into and execute the transmission line system franchise, which by this reference is fully incorporated herein as part of the motion. Said franchise is granted to the City of Kent for a period of twenty-five years. Said franchise shall include all of the general and special conditions required by the county.


B. If within 30 days after the granting of this franchise, the applicant shall have failed to sign the written acceptance incorporated herein, then the herein rights and privileges granted shall be forfeited and said franchise shall be null and void.
