MOTION NO. 7625

A MOTION establishing a King County Golf Course Committee to recommend alternatives to preserve golf courses for public use or open space.

WHEREAS, public golf courses provide large parcels of green space and afford active recreational opportunities for the citizens of King County, and

WHEREAS, golf is the fastest growing participatory recreation activity in the nation, and

WHEREAS, many golf courses in King County including Mt. View Golf Course, Wayne Golf Course, Lake Wilderness Golf Course, Mt. Si Golf Course and Tall Chief Golf Course, which collectively represent over one thousand acres of open spaces, have been identified by citizens as threatened with development, and

WHEREAS, the King County Open Space Citizens' Committee has recommended that King County launch an urgent effort to explore possible funding options to maintain public golf courses throughout the county;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


That a King County Golf Course Committee consisting of appropriate county staff and private citizens be appointed by the King County Council and report to the King County Executive and King County Council by February 15, 1990 on the following:

1. Existing golf course recreational opportunities.

- 1           2. Existing conditions and needed improvements at Mt. View,
- 2           Wayne, Lake Wilderness, Mt. Si and Tall Chief golf
- 3           courses.
- 4           3. Alternatives to preserve existing golf courses for public
- 5           use or as open space.
