A MOTION related to the Seattle King County Department of Public Health approving the Program Plan for the remodel of the Southeast (Renton) Public Health Center, and amending the Public Health Facility Master Plan.

WHEREAS, the facility plan for the Seattle-King County department of public health has been approved by the council, and

WHEREAS, the program plan for the remodeling of the Southeast (Renton) Public Health Center is based upon the approved facility plan, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 7159 Section 4.C. requires the approval of a program plan by the council prior to construction, and

WHEREAS, the scope of work for the remodeling is predicated on the assumption that a replacement facility near Valley Medical Center will open in 1992 and that the work represents the minimum known requirements to keep the center functional until 1992;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. That the program plan for the remodeling of the Southeast (Renton) Public Health Center is approved.


B. The following project is added to the public health facility master plan:
