9 and 1988; and

10 WHEREAS, he has been an effective advocate in promoting the  
11 acquisition, development and rehabilitation of park facilities  
12 and enhancing park and recreational opportunities in the Soos  
13 Creek, Enumclaw and Tahoma/Raven Heights areas through park  
14 capital improvements including Soos Creek Park, the Enumclaw  
15 Fairgrounds, Enumclaw Park, the Enumclaw Golf Course, Lake  
16 Meridian Park, Lake Wilderness Park, Farmers Park, Springwood  
17 Park, Lea Hill Park, the Lake Youngs Trail and the Auburn,  
18 Enumclaw, Kent, Renton and Tahoma Pools, and

19 WHEREAS, he has worked effectively to make sure public park  
20 facilities are available to all citizens of King County, making it  
21 a better place to live;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

23 The many community service contributions of Gary Grant be  
24 recognized and Soos Creek Park be renamed the Gary Grant Soos  
25 Creek Park in his honor.
