A MOTION approving the Agreement to Enter Into a Stipulated Order on Security, Staffing, Transportation, and Capacity Issues.

WHEREAS, King County entered into mediation in order to resolve issues in litigation concerning the transportation of inmates, the security of inmates and staff, and the inmate population capacity of the south dormitories of the King County Correctional Facility, and

WHEREAS, the county council desires to operate the King County Correctional Facility in a manner that meets new standards for custody that have evolved through case law, and

WHEREAS, the terms of the Agreement to Enter Into Stipulated Order on Security, Staffing, Transportation and Capacity Issues will allow King County to resolve the issues in mediation and to meet the new standards for custody;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Agreement to Enter Into Stipulated Order on Security, Staffing, Transportation, and Capacity Issues, signed by the parties to the agreement on November 1, 1989, is hereby approved.
