5 A MOTION requesting the county executive
6 insure protection of native indian burial
7 grounds consistent with state law.

8 WHEREAS, the Snoqualmie Valley Community Plan and Area Zoning
9 was enacted September 5, 1989 by Ordinance 9118, and

10 WHEREAS, the Snoqualmie Valley community planning area has a
11 rich historic background, and

12 WHEREAS, it is one of the traditional and current homelands
13 of the Snoqualmie Tribe, and

14 WHEREAS, the Snoqualmie Valley Community Plan recognizes
15 areas within the planning area which are culturally significant,
16 and

17 WHEREAS, the tribe is concerned about disturbance of burial
18 sites within the planning area, and

19 WHEREAS, state law adopted in 1989, Substitute Senate Bill
20 No. 5807, requires protection of indian graves and reinternment
21 of disturbed grave sites;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, be it moved by the Council of King County:


23 A. Native indian burial grounds and historic graves are
24 acknowledged to be a finite, irreplaceable, and nonrenewable
25 cultural resource, and are an intrinsic part of the cultural
26 heritage of the people of Washington.

27 B. The county executive is hereby requested to insure that
28 as part of development review, indian and historic graves are
29 protected in accordance with the requirements of state law,
30 Revised Code of Washington Chapters 27.44, 27.53 and 68.05 and
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1 persons disturbing historic graves through inadvertance, shall
2 reintern the human remains under the supervision of the cemetary
3 board.
