2 A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant
3 application for funds in the approximate amount of \$371,575
4 to support the Vashon Maury Island Ground Water Management
Plan by addition of a surface water quality and educational
component.

5 WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) is empowered by the Ground
6 Water Management Act to make grants to support plans to protect and preserve
7 ground water supplies from pollution and depletion; and

8 WHEREAS, the proposed Vashon and Maury Island Groundwater Management Plan
9 will develop recommendations for the protection and preservation of the
10 quality and quantity of ground water resources within the Vashon and Maury
11 Island management area.

12 WHEREAS, the Ground Water Management Plan will be augmented with data on
13 surface water quality which recharges the ground water on Vashon and Maury
14 Island, and with a model school curriculum integrating ground water protection
15 for K-12 education,

16 WHEREAS, the council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of
17 \$119,058 as an in-kind contribution of county resources and acknowledges
18 contributions from the citizens of Vashon of \$4,800 as an in-kind contribution
19 in support of the project,

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

21 A. The executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in
22 the approximate amount of \$371,575 to Ecology for a surface water quality and
23 educational component to the Vashon Maury Island Ground Water Management Plan
24 on behalf of King County;


25 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute
26 such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by
27 the grantor;

28 C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute
29 such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;
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1 D. Ecology is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil
2 Rights Act.
