7 during the 1989-1990 season.

8 WHEREAS, the University of Washington Women's Basketball
9 Team, also known as the HUSKIES, finished the season as
10 Washington's best team ever, winning 28 games, and

11 WHEREAS, this is the greatest number of games ever won by any
12 Husky women's basketball team, and qualified them for a
13 championship game in a National Collegiate Athletic Association
(NCAA) regional for the first time, and

14 WHEREAS, Washington earned an NCAA regional seeding of number
15 one for the first time at the conclusion of the regular season,
16 and won two tournament games before losing to Auburn in the
17 Midwest Regional Championship game in Iowa City, Iowa, to
18 conclude the season, and

19 WHEREAS, the Huskies made their sixth consecutive NCAA
20 Tournament appearance and finished the season ranked third in the
21 Associated Press Poll, making that ranking the best ever enjoyed
22 by a Huskies team, and

23 WHEREAS, the team's head coach, Chris Gobrecht, and assistant
24 coaches Kathy Anderson, Willette White, and graduate assistant
25 coach Charli Turner, are to be recognized for their inspiration
26 and coaching abilities, and can be justly proud of this team,
27 which has brought honor and prestige to the University of
28 Washington, the state and King County;

29 NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Moved: the King County Council wishes
30 to express gratitude for the endeavors of the coaches and the
