

MOTION NO. 7905

A MOTION authorizing the King County executive to sign an Agreement with the city of SeaTac and Port of Seattle to develop a park indoor activity center in North SeaTac Park.

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle and King County have, for many years, jointly pursued development of a park on vacant property north of the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, and

WHEREAS, the 1989 SeaTac Area Update recommends such park use on this property, and

WHEREAS, the passage of the 1989 open space bond measure provides the funds for the county and the recently incorporated city of SeaTac to participate in the full development of the park, and

WHEREAS, the city of SeaTac, the Port of Seattle, and King County have now reached agreement on development and financing of a new park indoor activity center as the first phase of development in the North SeaTac Park, and

WHEREAS, the North SeaTac Park Citizens Advisory Committee has unanimously endorsed the construction of a new park indoor activity center, and

WHEREAS, the city of SeaTac will fully participate with King County and the Port of Seattle in the development, operation, and maintenance of the North SeaTac Park;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is authorized to enter into an Agreement, substantially in the form attached, with the city of SeaTac and the Port of Seattle to develop a park indoor activity center in North SeaTac Park.
