MOTION NO. 7936

A MOTION authorizing approval of the Interlocal Agreement with the City of Seattle for distribution of Conservation Future Proceeds.

WHEREAS, state law grants counties the right to levy a conservation futures levy for the purpose of providing funds for open space acquisition, and

WHEREAS, conservation future levy revenue is collected by King County, and

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 8867 expressed the county's policy to allocate conservation futures to incorporated cities in order to facilitate the acquisition of open spaces throughout the county, and

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 9128 called on the Open Space Citizen Committee to review all requests for conservation futures levy proceeds and appropriated \$1,100,000 of proceeds to the City of Seattle, and

WHEREAS, the open Space Citizen's Committee has reviewed and approved the projects submitted by the City of Seattle;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is authorized to enter into and execute the attached conservation futures interlocal agreement with the City of Seattle, providing for distribution of Conservation Futures Proceeds.
