A MOTION recognizing the achievements and community service record of Adam Stubbs, winner of the 1990 Washington Youth of the Year Award for Boys and Girls Clubs of America.

WHEREAS, the King County Council wishes to honor and recognize Adam Stubbs who has excelled in the areas of community service, scholastic achievement, leadership, and personal accomplishment - attributes crucial to his success as 1990 Washington Youth of the Year for Boys and Girls Clubs of America, and

WHEREAS, Adam, an active participant in the Kirkland Boys and Girls Club, was selected to represent his club as a Youth of the Year contestant, and through local judging and interviews, was selected as a top candidate to represent Washington State, and

WHEREAS, on April 18, 1990, Adam was named Washington Youth of the Year and may now compete on a regional level July 13, 1990, for the opportunity to compete nationally with the possibility of being named United States Youth of the Year for Boys and Girls Clubs, and

WHEREAS, Adam should be recognized not only for his personal determination and goal-setting, which brought him through a difficult life of foster care and disruptive learning, but also for being more giving of himself to the needs of others in his community, and

WHEREAS, his volunteer work with the DARE program, his active involvement as President of the Youth Board of Northshore Family and Youth Services, and his election as Student Body President at Woodinville High School for the year 1990/1991 are but only a few of his exemplary services and accomplishments;
