9 Congress to reauthorize the National Endowment
10 for the Arts, without restriction, in 1990.

12 WHEREAS, the arts in the United States are an essential part of our cultural
13 heritage and identity and reflect the highest ideals of this nation; and

14 WHEREAS, the arts in King County are an integral part of our quality of life and a
15 major contributor to the uniqueness of this region; and

16 WHEREAS, the National Endowment for the Arts has for over twenty-five years
17 been a major factor in the growth of the arts in the United States and King County; and

18 WHEREAS, the National Endowment for the Arts has granted millions of dollars to
19 artists and arts organizations in King County, dollars which have leveraged major
20 increases in local contributions to the arts; and

21 WHEREAS, the National Endowment for the Arts is being considered for
22 reauthorization by the Congress in 1990; and

23 WHEREAS, the National Endowment for the Arts has been under attack recently by
24 those who want to limit and restrict the processes used by the National Endowment for the
25 Arts to make grants.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
27 June 27, 1990, shall be celebrated as National Endowment for the Arts Day in King
28 County. The United States Congress is urged to reauthorize the National Endowment for
29 the Arts, without restriction, in 1990.
