A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$600,000 to improve mental health services for homeless children and adolescents in King County.

WHEREAS, the National Institute of Mental Health (NIMH) is accepting grant applications for Child and Adolescent Service System Program (CASSP) Related Research Demonstration projects for comprehensive service system research for children and adolescents with severe emotional disturbance, including major mental disorders, and

WHEREAS, NIMH is making available from \$2.0 million to \$4.0 million to fund six to twelve grants nationwide, and

WHEREAS, the King County mental health division in cooperation with the University of Washington and four community agencies has prepared an application for a grant of approximately \$600,000 and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS) has indicated its support for King County's application, and

WHEREAS, DSHS is the eligible state mental health authority to submit an application for the federal grant funds, and

WHEREAS, receipt of the grant funds for a research demonstration project would enhance development of a system of services for homeless mentally ill children and adolescents in King County, and

WHEREAS, a demonstration project would further develop mental health services for children and youth in coordination with local agencies and the University of Washington, and

WHEREAS, a research demonstration project would be consistent with "King County Plan's for Mental Health Services: A New Direction" adopted by the King County Council in Motion No. 7656 on August 14, 1989, and

WHEREAS, the King County mental health board on May 8, 1989 voted unani-1 mously to recommend to the King County Council that an application be submitted 2 to NIMH for a demonstration grant, and 3 WHEREAS, deadline for submission of the County's application to DSHS is 4 June 8, 1990, and 5 WHEREAS, the deadline for DSHS's submission of the application to NIMH is 6 7 June 18, 1990; 8 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: 9 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application on 10 behalf of King County for funds in the approximate amount of \$600,000 through 11 the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services to the National 12 Institute of Mental Health for a demonstration grant for systems development for 13 services to homeless children and adolescents with severe emotional 14 disturbances. 15 The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such 16 applications and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the 17 grantor. 18 C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute 19 such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.
