3 A MOTION committing King County to requesting the 1991
4 Regular Session of the Legislature of the State of
5 Washington to authorize a reasonable affordable housing
6 exemption for first time home buyers from the voter
7 approved Real Estate Excise Tax Program and requesting the
8 King County Executive to provide the necessary staff to
9 assist the Legislature in formulating such an exemption.

10 WHEREAS, Laws 1990 1st. Ex. Sess., Ch. 5 authorizes counties
11 to submit for voter approval a real estate excise tax of up to one
12 percent for the acquisition and maintenance of open space lands; and

13 WHEREAS, King County Council Motion No. 7916 requested that the
14 Citizen's Oversight Committee on Open Space to explore and recommend
15 methods to exempt affordable housing transactions from the tax; and

16 WHEREAS, The Citizen's Oversight Committee has conducted a
17 series of four public meetings in June, 1990 at which the provision
18 of an exemption from the tax for first-time home buyers was
19 recommended by members of the general public; and

20 WHEREAS, The Citizen's Oversight Committee in its report on the
21 proposed tax entitled "The Real Estate Environmental Endowment"
22 (TREE), has recommended an exemption from the proposed real estate
23 excise tax for certain first time home buyers, those being persons
24 who generally meet the requirements of the Washington State Housing
25 Finance Commissions for participation in its mortgage revenue bond
26 programs; and

27 WHEREAS, current Washington State enabling legislation
28 authorizing the real estate excise tax for open space does not
29 provide measures of relief from the tax for first time home buyers
30 and such provision will require successful passage of an amendment
31 to RCW 82.46 in the 1991 Regular Session of the State Legislature;

1 WHEREAS, it is the express intent of the Council of King
2 County to insure affordable housing opportunities for first time
3 home buyers in King County;

4 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

5 A. The King County Council requests the Washington State
6 Legislature to pass, in its 1991 Regular Session by statute or, if
7 necessary, by constitutional amendment, an exemption to the real
8 estate excise tax for first time home buyers based on the
9 requirements used by the Washington State Housing Finance Commission
10 for its mortgage revenue bond programs, which are indexed yearly to
11 each counties' affordable housing market and personal income levels
12 and currently includes the following general guidelines for King
13 County:

- 14 1. The home purchased is intended to be used as a
15 principle residence.
- 16 2. The purchaser has had no present ownership interest in
17 a principle residence at any time during the 3 years
18 prior to the purchase.
- 19 3. The home is a single family residence.
- 20 4. The purchase price is less than \$125,000.
- 21 5. The maximum income of the purchaser shall be 20% above
22 the limit established by the Washington State Housing
23 Finance Commission.

24 B. King County is committed to pursue passage of the above
25 exemption an exemption to the real estate excise tax for acquisition
26 of conservation areas during the 1991 Regular Session of the
27 Washington State Legislature, in conjunction with other counties, in
28 which voters approve a similar tax for open space, that also wish to
29 provide relief from the tax for first time home buyers.

30 C. The Washington State Legislature is also requested to
31 consider whether the buyer or the seller should be assessed this
32 tax.

1 D. The King County Executive is requested to join with the
2 County Council in providing sufficient staff resources to pursue the
3 proposed amendment.
