A MOTION approving Vacation Appeal V-2039, appealing the denial of a road vacation request by the Department of Public Works; Ruben Korpi, Petitioner.

WHEREAS, the King County department of public works, after the required review of the vacation request, determined that the public would not benefit from the return of the requested vacation area to the public tax rolls, and

WHEREAS, the department of public works denied vacation request V-2039, and

WHEREAS, petitioner has appealed to the King County Council to overturn the denial of vacation request V-2039, and

WHEREAS, the King County council's Transportation and Public Works committee has heard testimony on this matter from both the petitioner and the department of public works, and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Public Works Committee has found the petitioner's appeal to have merit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

A. The appeal of road vacation petition V-2039,
initially denied by the King County department of public works,
is hereby approved and the decision of the King County
department of public works to deny vacation request V-2039 is
overturned.

B. The executive is directed to prepare an ordinance for council action granting vacation request V-2039 which is to contain, at a minimum, those elements prescribed by law. Said
