A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$23,246 to support creation of sewage treatment facilities plans to address a severe health hazard in the Vashon Island communities of Beulah Park/Cove and Spring Beach, Grant File 018/61.

WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology is authorized to make grants of funds under the Interim Program of the Centennial Clean Water Fund to support projects to correct public health hazards; and facilities in areas declared to be severe hazards, and

WHEREAS, the Vashon Island communities of Beulah Park/Cove and Spring Beach have been declared to be severe public health hazard areas by the Washington State Department of Health, and

WHEREAS, the public health hazards are the most serious characteristics attributable to inadequate sewage systems discovered by the Seattle/King County department of public health during the Vashon sanitary survey now being completed, and

WHEREAS, the sewage disposal problems encountered have a community-wide impact and are not resolvable by performing individual residential sewage system repairs due to very unfavorable site conditions, and

WHEREAS, the affect communities are outside any sewer district service area, and

WHEREAS, the council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$2,498 as an in-kind contribution and \$3,313 as cash in 1990 and \$7,494 in-kind contribution and \$9,941 cash in 1991;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$23,246 to

1 the Washington State Department of Ecology to support
2 development of sewage treatment facilities plans for the Vashon
3 Island communities of Spring Beach and Beulah Park/Cove.

4 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file
5 and execute such application and enter into and execute such
6 contracts as are required by the grantor;

7 C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter
8 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
9 implementation of the project;

10 D. The Department of Ecology is hereby assured full
11 compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
