3 A MOTION authorizing the executive to
4 make a grant application for funds in
5 the approximate amount of \$173,665 to
6 support development of a regional
7 emergency medical services and trauma
8 care system.

10 WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature adopted the
11 Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Care Systems Act in order
12 to promote a system of emergency medical services and trauma
13 care, and

14
15 WHEREAS, an efficient and well coordinated emergency medical
16 services and trauma care system can reduce costs and the incidence
17 of inappropriate and inadequate patient care, and minimize the
18 human suffering and costs associated with preventable mortality
19 and morbidity, and

20
21 WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Health, Office of
22 Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and Trauma Systems is authorized
23 to make grants to support development of a regional EMS and
24 trauma care system, and

25
26 WHEREAS, the Seattle King County Emergency Medical Services
27 and Trauma Care Council has endorsed a proposal for the King
28 County Emergency Medical Services Division to receive funding
29 from the State and to perform activities on behalf of the EMS
30 and Trauma Care Council related to the development of a regional
31 emergency medical services and trauma care system;

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

33
34 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make
35 application for funds in the approximate amount of \$173,665 to
36 the Washington State Department of Health, Office of EMS and
37 Trauma Systems to support development of a regional emergency
38 medical services and trauma care system on behalf of King County.

40 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and
41 execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts
42 as are required by the grantor.

C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the projects.

D. The Department of Health is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
