A MOTION authorizing the county executive to enter into an interlocal agreement with the Port of Seattle, and King County International Airport relating to the funding of a study to examine the feasibility of consolidating the county airport and Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SeaTac).

WHEREAS, the County and the Port of Seattle are interested in examining the feasibility of consolidating management of King County International Airport in the Port of Seattle or other appropriate regional agency, and

WHEREAS, the Port has agreed to undertake the lead role in contracting for and preparing the feasibility study, and

WHEREAS, the County is interested in evaluating the advantages and disadvantages of such consolidation and desires to contribute to the cost of the feasibility study;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is authorized to execute an interlocal agreement, substantially in the form attached, with the Port of Seattle and King County International Airport for the Port to conduct a study examining the feasibility of consolidating the county airport and SeaTac.
